

A NATURE WALK WITH

HEY DUGGEE



Hey Duggee and the Squirrels love exploring and learning about nature. For some Red Nose Day fun, why not go on a sponsored nature walk with your little ones? Make sure you follow Duggee's five easy steps to do this responsibly:

- Watch carefully
- Stay at a distance
- Don't interfere
- Be patient
- Stay quiet

- 1** Spring is in the air! Plan a short walk near your setting that includes some natural spaces — perhaps to a local park, a local pond or garden.
- 2** Explain to your little ones that nature can be found everywhere. In 'The Nature badge' the Squirrels look in lots of places for nature: the jungle, the desert, the arctic and the sea. What do they think the Squirrels might see?
- 3** Now you're going to go out for a walk to see what you can find! Why not use your walk to earn your 'Fundraising badge'? You could ask for donations to take part or turn it into a sponsored stroll. Simply share your JustGiving link. Register at comicroelief.com/register to get yours.
- 4** While you're out adventuring, remind your little ones what to look out for. Ask questions to get them searching, talking, counting and having fun, for example:
 - Can you find a green leaf?
 - How about a yellow one?
 - How many birds can you see flying in the sky?
 - Who can find the tallest tree?
 - What noise does a bee make?
 - Where might you find one?
 - Are there lots of clouds today?
 - Do you think it's going to rain?
 - What's your favourite type of stick? Thick? Thin? Long? Short? Curvy?
- 5** Fill in the 'What did you spot?' sheet. You could either do this as a group or print off a copy of the sheet for the children to fill in themselves (show them how to do a tick!).




